





BIRTH/MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE REGISTRATION

REGISTRATION OF BIRTH PROCEDURE, MALAYSIAN BORN ABROAD

- Malaysians born abroad can be registered at any Malaysian Mission on the condition:
 - i) Father of the child is a Malaysian citizen
 - ii) Registration is made within one year from the date of birth
 - iii) Date of birth / age
 - iv) Address in home country
 - v) Address of relative or next of kin that can be contacted
- 2. Apart from bringing the child to the Mission, documents required for registration are as follow:-

a.	Passport and Identity card (ID card) of parents
b.	Original Birth Certificate of Parents and Chinese Notary of Birth-
	Certificate for Chinese
C.	Malaysia Marriage Certificate
d.	Child's Original Birth Certificate issue by hospital
e.	Notarized certificate of Child's Birth which has to be in bilingual
	and attested by Ministry of Foreign Affairs Office (FAO) of the
	Country or Province of issue
f.	3 Identical Photos of Child Passport Size



3. Fees for submission of application 'Form D' and for issuance citizenship certificate 'Borang H' is RMB65.00

Note: -

For registration made beyond the period of one (1) year after the birth process 1-3 still applies. The Consulate will forward the application to the National Registration Department of Malaysia for approval. Feedback of the application (approved or otherwise) will be notified to the applicant.

The child born in Malaysia can be a Malaysian if either parents (father or mother) is a citizen of Malaysia.

REGISTRATION OF MARRIAGE PROCEDURE

Malaysian citizens wishing to marry in CHINA need to understand that the Local Marriage Registration Offices have their own procedures and requirements.

Malaysian citizens who are wishing to marry in CHINA must contact the China Marriage Registration Office in advance for details. The Chinese Marriage Registration Office in SHANGHAI can be contacted at No. 82 Cao Bao Lu, Shanghai or telephone number (8621) 64325087.

As part of the requirements, Malaysian citizens must submit the following documents for marriage registration to the Consulate General of Malaysia in Shanghai.

a.	Original Passport and Identity card (ID card) husband and wife.
b.	Malaysia Birth Certificate for Malaysian and Chinese Notary of Birth-Certificate for Chinese (attested by Respective Foreign Affairs Office).
C.	China Marriage certificate issued by the local Marriage Bureau
d.	Notarial certificate of marriage which has to be in bilingual and attested by respective Foreign Affairs Office (FAO) of the Province of issue of Marriage Certificate.
e.	Three (3) copies of color passport size photograph for husband and wife.
f.	Form JPN.KC06 (Fill this form during appointment).
g.	All original documents (a – d) need to make three (3) set of copies of the following documents.

- 1) Marriage certificate issued by any country which is not in English must be translated to English and attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the country of issue, and Embassy / Consulate General of Malaysia / Consulate of the respective country.
- 2) Malaysian subject MUST re-register with a Consulate General Office within 6 months from the date of marriage, otherwise a penalty of CNY200.00 will be imposed from the first year of marriage and CNY100.00 for every subsequent year. Fees for marriage registration is CNY82.00.
